

NOTICE OF TEMPORARY AMENDMENT TO AVOP PROGRAM



Kamloops Airport apron users:

Please note that there will be a temporary amendment to the AVOP "DA" permitting procedure, specifically section 1.0 "AVOP Testing" of the KAL AVOP manual.

Due to higher volumes of Apron users and service vehicles requiring access to Apron 1 during wildfire suppression operations, the Kamloops Airport AVOP DA licencing procedure will be temporarily amended during this time. The driving portion of the "DA" AVOP will not be required during the effective period.

This amendment applies only to persons involved in forestry wildfire activities who need access to the main apron with vehicles and equipment. This does not apply to persons requiring a full AVOP D.

***Please note: if you are currently operating a vehicle on the main apron and you do not have an AVOP issued by the Kamloops Airport, you must cease apron activities until you can obtain an appropriate AVOP permit from Kamloops Airport Ltd.**

Procedure for temporary AVOP DA candidates:

- View and study the current AVOP manual at www.kamloopsairport.com,
- download and complete the application and return to the Airport Operations office (101-3035 Airport Rd., phone 250.376.3613), and
- successfully complete a written test at the Airport Operations office.
- A successful candidate will receive a temporary AVOP DA pass. This pass must be worn at all times when operating inside the AVOP DA area.
- Candidates that possess a RAIC will need to complete this testing in addition to providing their RAIC.

Effective period: July 10, 2017 to August 31, 2017. These dates are subject to change at the discretion of Kamloops Airport Ltd.
