Kamloops Airport announces the traveler numbers for the month of March as compared to the same period in the previous year:

	2012	2013	Change
Monthly Travelers	25,023	25,750	2.8%
Year-To-Date Travelers	74,276	76,371	2.7%

Kamloops Airport saw continued growth in March consistent with preceding months. A particularly strong ski season and increases in commuting and business travel are also contributing factors. Tavellers are also taking advantage of improved connections to the Air Canada and WestJet sun destination networks.

The following aircraft movements were recorded in March as compared to the same period in the previous year:

IFR	1,179	1,113	-6%
VFR	<u>589</u>	<u>971</u>	<u>40%</u>
Total	1,768	2,084	17.9%

The additional aircraft movements are generally related to increased oil and gas sector employee charters along with commercial and private ski charters. It is expected that with the expanded hours now available to clear Canada Customs as Kamloops Airport, there will be increases in private aircraft during the ski season.
