Kamloops Airport announces the traveler numbers for the month of November as compared to the same period in the previous year.

Monthly Travelers	26,383	25,470	-3.5%
Year-To Date Travelers	291,821	293,083	0.4%

In the month of October an error was detected in the number of travelers and that error is corrected this month in the Year to Date Travelers number. November follows the general trend for this year with a fall in the number of travelers to the Northern Alberta market. Air carriers report some initial signs of recovery though as energy companies start the process of bringing people back on staff and this bodes well for the Kamloops market of migrating workers.

The following aircraft movements were recorded in November as compared to the same period in the previous year:

VFR	801	1,012	26%

A major project to rehabilitate the eastern portion of the main apron has completed the 2016 work. Work to complete the eastern portion of apron will get under way in April 2017 with completion by the end of May. The Province of BC is funding 75% the work under the BC Air Access program. Aircraft are now using the completed portion.
