Biosphere Certification evaluates destinations and organizations through a rigorous process that measures performance in areas such as climate action, resource efficiency, social responsibility, and visitor experience. This recognition acknowledges a range of impactful initiatives implemented by Kamloops Airport across environmental, community, and corporate stewardship, including energy efficient LED upgrades on the airfield and in operations and terminal buildings, and adding occupancy sensors to reduce energy use in unoccupied areas.
